Technology

Last week our students covered Health and Safety by identifying hazards in the kitchen and ways to maintain safety for self and others. They also had to name utensils used in the kitchen and their purposes. To finish they created pinwheel scrolls/scones with a collaboration between groups of sweet cinnamon and sour parsley and chives. This involved time management, sensory evaluation and collaboration.

This week students will further develop their practical cooking skills to make a functional and healthy food product that can be recreated at home. They will also consider constraints, hygiene, specification and sustainability issues that inform decisions about preparing and cooking healthy meals. While this sounds complicated - it is guaranteed to be YUM!
