

Hauroko Valley Primary School had several qualifiers representing Western Southland at the 2023 Southland Primary School Athletics Sports. The track and field events were held on Saturday 25th March at Surrey Park, Invercargill.

Throughout the day our students represented in a range of running – 60m, 100m, 200m, 800m, and 1500m events with some qualifying for finals. Lily was second in both the 800m and 1500m finals – which is a superb achievement. Several of our fastest 100m runners were placed in Western Southland relay teams. Relays are always a highlight to end the day.

Meanwhile, in the field events, we had representation in the long jump, shot put, nerf and discus. There were some fantastic personal bests from our students throwing or jumping further than they have before. At this level students are required to meet Southland standards for their jump or throw to be measured. Well done to our athletes as they impressed with their skill development.
