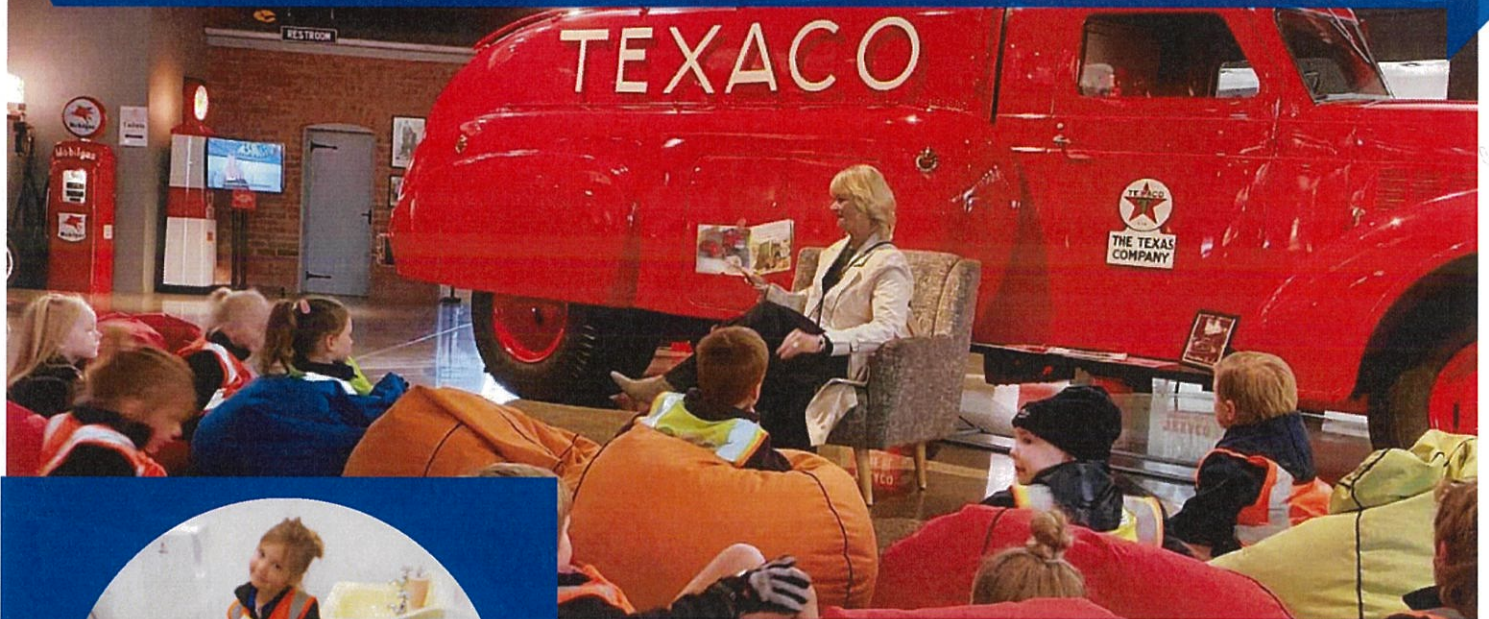

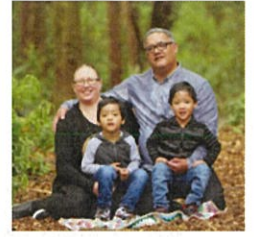
We have RAT tests available for anyone in need. These can be arranged for you to pick up from the school office.

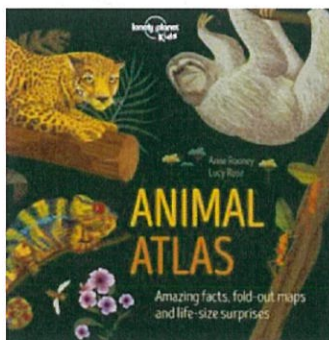

The Animal Atlas from Lonely Planet Kids is an unfolding adventure of maps to reveal animals from every continent.



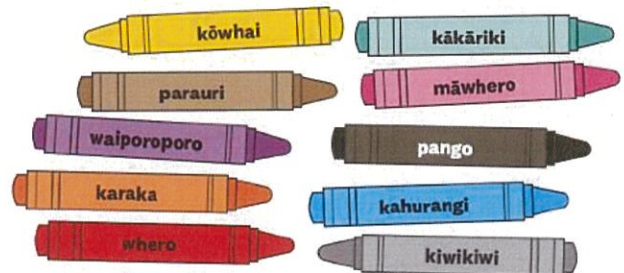

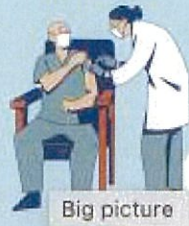
