

YEAR SEVEN VISION SCREENING

The Vision Hearing Technicians from Te Whatu Ora - Southern will be visiting your school to screen all year seven students for distance vision shortly.

Screening Provided:

Distance Vision (Amblyopia & Hyperopia)
 This determines how well your child can see at a distance. It involves reading an eye

If you do not wish your child to be screened, please fill out an optout slip, which are available at the school office before our visit.

This free vision check is <u>not required</u> if student wears glasses and/or is currently under care of an optometrist or eye specialist (with in the last six months).

In this case you <u>do not</u> need to fill in an opt-out slip as we ask all children before we screen if they fall into this category.


