



Hauroko Valley Primary School Teacher Aide Positions

We have two fixed term Teacher Aide positions, commencing Thursday 1st February and ceasing Monday 16th December 2024.

The hours of work include 26&1/4 hours per week (5&1/4 hours daily), starting at 9.00am and finishing at 3.00pm weekdays.

Purpose of Position

A person working directly or indirectly in classrooms with teachers, to support a range of students, by working flexibly within teaching and learning programmes.

Core Skills

Listening, patience, empathy, encouraging and resilience. Additional skills at this level may include: active listening, calmness and tact.

General Support

To follow structured programmes, lesson plans and activities and make minor adaptations or create activities.

Additional Support

Directly support students wellbeing, health and safety with specific health, behavioural and/or other needs.

Te Ao Maori

Developing familiarity and ability to function on an informal basis.




