PEPEHA ART WORK



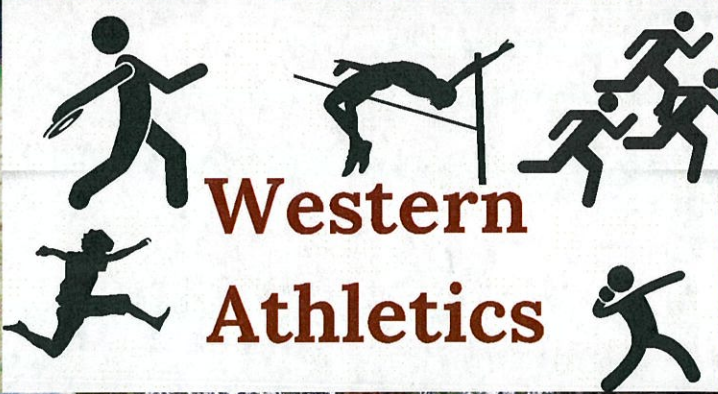
O FOR OWL



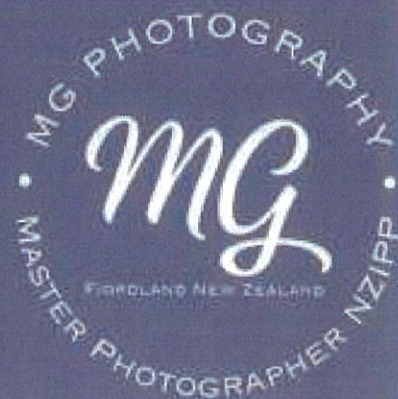

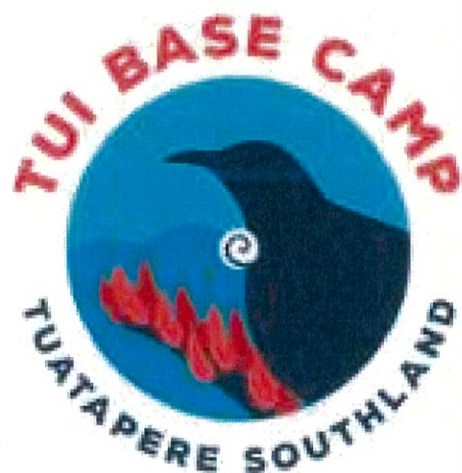

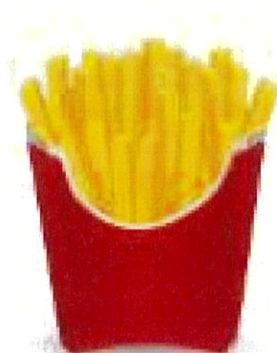
